


# Whole Heart (Hold Me Now)

**G<sup>maj7</sup>** D A

Find me now Where the grace runs as deep as Your scars

## PRE-CHORUS 1

A Bm **G<sup>maj7</sup>** D A  
You pulled me from the clay, Set me on a rock  
A Bm **G<sup>maj7</sup>** D/F# A  
Called me by Your Name And made my heart whole again

**V2** **G<sup>maj7</sup>** D A  
Lifted up And my knees know it's all for Your glory  
That I might stand With more reasons to sing than to fear (to pre-chorus)

**CHORUS** Bm<sup>7</sup> A D G  
So here I stand High in surrender, I need You now  
Bm<sup>7</sup> A D G  
Hold my heart Now and forever My soul cries out

**BRIDGE 1** Bm<sup>7</sup> A D G  
Once I was broken But You loved my whole heart through  
Bm<sup>7</sup> A D  
Sin has no hold on me 'Cause Your grace holds me now

**BRIDGE 2** Bm<sup>7</sup> A D G  
Healed and forgiven Look where my chains are now  
Bm<sup>7</sup> A D  
Death has no hold on me 'Cause Your grace holds that ground

**TAG** Bm<sup>7</sup> A D G  
Your grace holds me now Your grace holds me now

**V3** **G<sup>maj7</sup>** D A  
And that grace Owns the ground where the grave did  
Where all my shame remains Left for dead in Your wake  
A Bm **G<sup>maj7</sup>** D A  
You crashed those age-old gates, You left no stone unturned  
A Bm **G<sup>maj7</sup>** D/F# A  
You stepped out of that grave And shouldered me all the way (to chorus 1)
